## **KTP COUNCIL MEMBER ELECTED ON THE ARCHITECTS' COUNCIL OF EUROPE EXECUTIVE BOARD**

Perit Vincent Cassar, currently a member of the Council of the Kamra tal-Periti, has been elected on the Executive Board of the Architects' Council of Europe (ACE) during elections which were held last Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November in Brussels.

Seven representatives from six different European Chambers, including Spain, France, Poland, United Kingdom, Belgium and Malta contested the elections, held during the General Assembly of the ACE. Perit Cassar was the third elected with a total of 258 votes from 19 different countries. Finnish Architect, Juhani Katainen was elected President during the same elections.

ACE is an influential organisation based in Brussels which aims at the promotion of the understanding of Architecture as a matter of public interest vested in the quality of the built environment. It works to safeguard the promotion and recognition of the Architect's role within society and the maintenance of the highest standards of Architectural education.

The KTP has, in the last few years, been member of the ACE and has participated in a number of workgroups. This collaboration with the ACE have in fact been of great influence on the workings of the Kamra over the last three years and has led to the recent publication of the KTP's Position Paper entitled, *The Urban Challenge – Quality of Life and The Built Environment*.

This is the second time the Kamra tal-Periti is to be represented on the ACE. Perit David Felice, the current President of the Kamra was a member of the Executive Board in 2006 and was the ACE delegate on the European Forum for Architectural Policies (EFAP). Moreover, Perit David Pace, past President of the Kamra tal-Periti is also the Secretary General of the Mediterranean Union of Architects (UMAR).
